LEVELS

Elementary

At this level, you will learn to:

- Understand many simple expressions of everyday life
- Produce questions and answers involving basic information
- Follow simplified stories or information
- Write a few simple, connected sentences on a given topic

Pre-Intermediate

At this level, you will learn to:

- Take part in commonplace conversations if spoken to carefully
- Perform most everyday social and practical functions
- Understand the main idea and details of simple, authentic texts
- Write coherent short compositions using simple but varied structures correctly

Intermediate

At this level, you will learn to:

- Understand the gist of a commonplace conversation involving fluent speakers and make substantial relevant contributions
- Give and receive information by asking and answering relevant questions
- Understand the main idea and intention of most straightforward, authentic reading texts
- Write effective communications involving information or opinion

Upper-Intermediate

At this level, you will learn to:

- Understand well enough to hold a continuous conversation with a native speaker
- Manage all normal life functions with ease, and cope linguistically with completely new situations
- Understand most non-specialist texts and respond to different types of writing
- Produce fluent writing and use complex sentence structures without many errors

Advanced

At this level, you will learn to:

- Understand native speakers of everyday standard English and take part in normal interactions
- Produce speech fluent enough to convey feeling, to argue and maintain a point of view, or to convey complex information
- Recognise and respond to different styles of writing while appreciating shades of meaning
- Write fluently and with relatively few errors on any topic and in a range of styles.
